

Double Decker

Activity

Students are shown 6 different types of ice cream. If Ziggy, the monster, wants to make double deckers (2-scoop ice creams), how many different possible combinations can it make? Note, we consider chocolate on top of vanilla as the same combination as vanilla on top of chocolate.

To support

- ① Provide students with 6 different coloured blocks to represent the different flavours.
 - Students can physically create possible double deckers.
- ② Students could explore possible combinations. They don't need to find the exact total.

To challenge

- ① Students could:
 - explore how the total would change if a fifth flavour was introduced or one flavour was taken away.

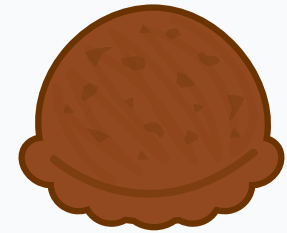
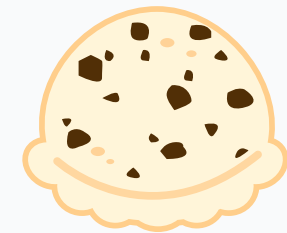
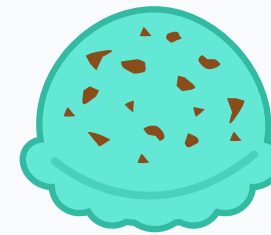


Double Decker
